8:05 AM – Meeting called to order by Mr. Cunningham.

8:06 AM – The roads budget was talked about concerning the \$300,000 Loan that the voters authorized. Mr. Weston came in and suggested that the board not do the top 2 ½" top coat on the Brook this year, to allow the culverts to settle for the winter and just do the base coat. That would cut a little over \$200,000 off the budget. By waiting a year, it would also give you a better road after paving the top coat and the culverts would have settled. The town would also pave the apron up the Dump Road and fix the drainage that comes down into the Brook Road Culvert. Mr. Ackland asked about the Lincoln Gap section the top part. Ms. Jones commented that the Town is trying to get a grant and partnership with the wildlife service and the Town of Lincoln but it would not happen this year. Mr. Weston commented that the lower section of Lincoln could wait another year if it had to from the schedule as there were some big culverts that needed to be changed. Mr. Cunningham commented about the intersection of Airport and Dump Road about making a "T" intersection rather than a straight throughway down Dump Road. Mr. Weston commented we could ask VTRANS for assistance on that intersection and see what they come up with. Mr. Cunningham remembers that it was talked about and he thought permission was given by the landowner to do that. The board felt it was worth following up with VTANS on. Mr. Weston also talked about the Airport section of road that was planned for paving from the end of pavement to Cold Springs Road from the RT 100 end. He commented that they could take that off the plan which was around \$90,000 making the budget \$300,000 lower. The drainage and erosion project would still be done as we have a grant for that work. Mr. Weston also commented that we often budget a little high as we do not know what the price of asphalt will be and it usually comes in lower than what was budgeted. The board commended Mr. Weston for looking at the plan and coming up with a workable solution so the board would not have to take a loan.

8:30 AM – Other Business

Road Curb Cut Applications – Ms. Jones ask the board who would be looking at these since Mr. Simpson is on leave for health reasons. Mr. Cunningham commented that he would be the person looking at them.

Mr. Youmell would also set Mr. Simpson up access at his home to be able to retrieve his emails and be able to get his phone messages.




