• To vote for a person whose name is not printed on the ballot, write or stick his or her name in the blank space provided and fill in the oval to the right of the write-in line.

• Do not vote for more candidates than the "VOTE for NOT MORE THAN #" for an office.

• If you make a mistake, tear, or deface the ballot, return it to an election official and obtain another ballot. DO NOT ERASE.
