



- Maine has 46,000 cases an increase of 2,300 cases





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Update on outbreaks and clusters as of March 3,2021

- 86 Active outbreaks, 75 Primary and 11 Secondary, 184 outbreaks have been resolved.
- There are currently 634 cases among residents and 364 cases among the facility staff in Congregate Care & Living. These are totals overall and the in past 2 weeks only 47 cases of residents

Governors, CDC and SEOC Updates


- CDC says you can gather indoors with fully vaccinated people without wearing a mask.
- You can gather indoors with unvaccinated people from one other household (for example, visiting with relatives
 who all live together) without masks, unless any of those people or anyone they live with has an increased risk
 for severe illness from COVID-19.
- If you've been around someone who has COVID-19, you do not need to stay away from others or get tested unless you have symptoms.
- The Governor will be issuing new guidance on gatherings and restaurants during Friday's press conference.
- The Governor also eased guidelines for VT long term care facilities.

Testing

- Testing continues to happen at 17 sites a day throughout the state.
- Weekend Testing at Waitsfield United Church on March 13th, 14th, 20th, 21st, 27th and 28th
- Testing continues to be offered almost daily in Barre, Northfield, Waterbury, Middlebury, Berlin and Williamstown


Vaccination Planning

- Phase 5A is currently available for signups and starting Thursday the 11th, Phase 5B begins which is those 16+ with certain high-risk health conditions.
- Teachers and Childcare workers are eligible to signup starting on Monday the 15th
- Nearly 82.5% of those 75+ age group have at least 1 dose and 64.3% of those 70-74 have at least 1 dose
- About 127,454 have been vaccinated in VT. Nearly 68,900 have completed their doses
- Vermont is 3rd in the Northeast with 31.85 doses administered per 100 residents, VT is 13th in the country.
- Nearly 85% of Vermonters will or probably will get vaccinated
- More than 61,000,000 have been vaccinated nationwide, 32,100,000 have received 2 doses
- Nearly 123,000,000 doses have been distributed nationwide



HIGH-RISK HEALTH CONDITIONS INCLUDED IN PHASE 5

- Current cancer
- Chronic kidney disease
- COPD, including emphysema and chronic bronchitis
- Heart disease, including heart attack, heart failure, congestive heart failure, coronary artery disease (angina, acute and chronic ischemic heart disease), cardiomyopathies, and pulmonary hypertension. Does NOT include high blood pressure.
- Immunocompromised (weakened immune system), due to solid organ transplant, blood, or bone marrow transplant, immune deficiencies, or other causes; or HIV with a low CD4 cell count or not on HIV treatment; prolonged use of corticosteroids or other immune suppressing drugs.
- Severe obesity (BMI of 40 or above)
- Pregnancy
- Type 1 and Type 2 diabetes
- Disabilities including chromosomal disorders, such as Down syndrome; intellectual disabilities (IQ of 70 or below); disabilities that compromise lung function (neurologic and muscular conditions such as muscular dystrophy, spina bifida, cystic fibrosis, and multiple sclerosis).
- Sickle cell disease






