Management Recommendations

Land Use Plan

Low impact recreation including use of the mowed field, Mad River Path connection, riparian forest re-vegetation minimum 50 feet and Route 100 screening vegetation.

Planting

Plant to be developed in coordination with Friends Of The Mad River (FMR) and Mad River Path.
Explore the possibility of the United States Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) extending the plantings to a strip along the river and on the southern side of the parcel's entrance road.

Mowing:

Mowing of the grassy area.
Maintaining the Mad River Path.

Education Signage:

Management Plan description
Dog feces control
Japanes Knotweed control
Mad River Path educational materials
Wildlife Corridor awareness

Parking Area:

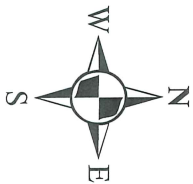
Maintain the current parking lot and fence.
