

**MINUTES OF JUNE 6, 2007**  
**WARREN SELECT BOARD**  
**EMERGENCY MEETING**

**8:00 AM**

**MEMBERS PRESENT:** Mac Rood, Chair, Barry Simpson, Erin Russell-Story, Kirstin Reilly, Burt Bauchner.

**OTHERS PRESENT:** Ken Friedman, Cindi Jones

**8:00 AM** – Meeting called to order by Mr. Rood.

Mr. Friedman started the meeting off by giving the board an update on the seriousness of the town computer server. When Mr. Friedman started to install a backup program onto the server, it froze and crashed. After conversations with Dell Computer and Mr. Butcher it was determined that the one of the 3 drives was non workable and that the information was being passed on the additional 2 alternate drives. All information contained on the drives is non recoverable and has to be sent out to a data recovery service.

Mr. Friedman suggested the following solutions: (1) try a software program costing around \$100 which has never been used on Rad software before and see if he can recover the data. (2) Send all three drives out to a data recovery service. Mr. Friedman indicated he had received quotes from Drive Safe, a company based in California, which would cost somewhere between \$2,500-\$7,600 depending on how much they could recover. If they were unsuccessful in recovering the data it would cost \$342. Another company he checked with was On Track and they would charge between \$5,800-\$10,000 and are a New England based company. The other company was a company in England at a price of \$5,800-\$5,900, however, that would require sending the data drives out of the US. In the interim Dell has sent 3 new drives which Mr. Friedman will install in the server and try to bring the individual office computers back onto the server.

The Town has a data recovery backup contract with NEMRC on the accounting files and Ms. Jones, called NEMRC to respond that Tuesday with a backup. NEMRC has restored it to the treasurer's and clerk's computers. NEMRC restored the data as of June 8 which was the last automated backup received from the server.






