**Minutes of 12/13/2022**

**Members Present:** Andrew Cunningham, Vice Chair, Luke Youmell, Chair, Robert Ackland & Devin Klein Corrigan.

**6:35 PM – Public Comment** – Mr. Egan commented that the telecom piece has been taken out of the new Land Use Development Regulations and that the current Land Use Development Regulations has addressed telecommunications. He also commented that 13 other towns have amended their Land Use Development Regulations to have a better, more restrictive language for telecommunications projects. He also asked which regulations are currently in effect? Ms. Robbins commented that once the Selectboard has had their hearing the new Land Use Development Regulations will be in force along with the current regulations until the Land Use Development Regulations are approved by the Selectboard.

**6:44 PM – Planning Zoning Budget** – Ruth Robbins, Zoning Administrator – Ms. Robbins returned with her budget with clarification on a few things discussed at the first meeting. After conversations concerning the two legal lines in the DRB and Planning Commission Budgets, the board felt that the DRB legal budget line should be increased to \$2,000 and leave the Planning Commission Legal budget line at \$1,000. She did increase the budget hours for her office assistant a few more hours. Ms. Robbins commented that she felt comfortable with her budget hours for her assistants. She also projected about \$40,000 in fees for 2023.

**8:08 PM – Washington County Sheriff's Department** - Captain Myer first introduced Mr. Poulin as the new Washington County Sherriff assuming his new role on February 1, 2023. He served with Captain Myer for the last 15 years as his partner in patrol duties. Mr. Poulin provided the board some information on the Sheriff's Department and that they have been working a plan to financially sustain the Sheriff's Department. They are having the same hiring issues as other businesses to find people to apply for a position as full-time or part-time deputy. Warrens contract is for 20 hours week with a budget of \$31,500 and last year's hourly rate was \$31.50 plus mileage. Most places are starting out at \$34.00/hour to offset the costs incurred by the Sherriff's Department. Their current rate is unsustainable for all that they must cover. Starting with the new contract in March their rate will be going up to \$60.00/hour to become financially sustainable. Captain Myer and Sheriff Poulin felt very comfortable that they will be able to meet the need to complete the 20 hours a week. Captain Myer also presented to the board traffic stats from 04/01/2022-12/12/22. All towns are experiencing higher speeds then before on their roads. Most are 30+ in excessive of the posted speed limit. Captain Myer also suggested to ask the State to lower the speed on RT 100 from Jiffy Mart to the Access Road as they have responded to numerous crashes at the intersection.

He also suggested to the board lowering the complete Access Road down to a lower speed than the posted 40 MPH. The board thanked both for coming in.

**7:40 PM – Jeff Campbell – Fire Truck Visit** – Mr. Campbell traveled down to PA to look at the proposed fire Truck that was discussed at the last meeting for purchasing. He commented that it is spotless and clean underneath. It mechanically runs good as well. They negotiated the price down to \$196,000 from \$198,000 that included all the required tests, oil test, ladder test, compression test and shipping. They would also help the Town with sending the old one down there to an auction.

**7:37 PM Budget FY 23 – Wages, Paving Schedule, and capital** – After the Sheriff's discussion, the board adjusted the budget line for the Sherriff's Department to \$43,680 from the current \$32,500.

**Paving Schedule** – Mr. Ackland commented that he had met with Mr. Bombard and they had decided not to pave anything for FY23. The \$240,000 that is in the general highway budget will be moved to the Capital Account and the Capital Account allocation would be the same funding as last year at \$240,000. It was asked why are we not paving? Mr. Ackland commented that the Town does not have enough money in the Capital Fund to do the Brook Road and East Warren Road. Mr. Bombard felt that they were ok to wait for another year. It changes the paving schedule to be a year behind.

**Capital Accounts** – Ms. Jones commented that the Capital Accounts for Fire are updated by Mr. Campbell and that the Highway Capital would be updated by Mr. Bombard. Town reappraisal -0-, Mapping -0-, Conservation Fund \$20,000 as discussed in a previous meeting and agreed on by the board, Paving - \$240,000 + the general highway line item of \$240,000, Library Building Improvement Fund \$5,000, Town Improvements \$25, 000, Town Planning and development – Ms. Jones noted that GSI cost of \$72,370 would need to be figure in, however, the board needed to discuss about the Town Garage. The current allocation is at \$55,000. Wastewater \$21,330 includes monitoring well replacements and aquatic stream testing for nitrates and phosphorus. Cemetery \$10,000 up \$5,000, Ms. Jones had confirmed with the Cemetery Treasurer. State Lister Training -0-, Blueberry dam and covered bridge – (did not discuss). The Capital Fund will be discussed in more detail at a Capital Budget Hearing and prior to the hearing in January.

**Wages:** Mr. Ackland commented that Mr. Bombard has come to him to ask about increasing two highway personnel wages, one would be at 15.8% and the other 13.75%. He did not want to go into detail. Mr. Youmell commented let us establish a base line for wages and then go from there with that request: The SSA is at 8.7%, Average inflation is at 7.1% for the last 12 months and the Bureau of Labor Cost Statistics reported 4.6% to 6.4%. Mr. Cunningham commented that it should not be tied into inflation as it never has been before. Mr. Ackland commented that retention of employees has become a big part of wage discussions of late. Mr. Youmell suggested 7% across the board and Ms. Klein Corrigan suggested 8%. The board agreed to go with 7.5% across the board.

**Other Business:**

**Next Meeting Date:** - The board discussed the next two meetings in December. They decided not to meet on December 20<sup>th</sup> and meet on December 27<sup>th</sup> the last meeting for the year.

**Land Use Development Regulations Public Meeting** – The board agreed to warn the Land Use Development Regulations on January 24<sup>th</sup> for the Valley Reporter publication on the 26<sup>th</sup>s and hold the Public Hearing on February 14, 2023

Verizon - The Planning Commission met last night and the Town's Attorney has contacted Verizon's lawyers. The Town Attorney is planning on attending the meetings with Verizon on January 9, 2023 and January 23, 2023. Mr. Youmell will follow up again to find out if the Town's Attorney has sent anything to Verizon on the public comment period as they had cancelled on December 12, 2022 which limited the public comment period. Next update will be December 27, 2022.

Ms. Klein Corrigan also read the attached comment email from the Warren Conservations Commission concerns. Mr. Youmell also acknowledge Mr. Bronfin's letter on his concerns about the Verizon Tower.


