

Meeting Minutes WRC

1/2/25, 1:00pm

Discussion:

Budget 2025

1. Pierre has a call out to Nate from SOS to understand what are required offsets from leach field height and locations of feed pipes to leach field. We want to widen the road for more parking and need this to understand if it is possible.
2. Kevin Collins (802-279-8359) is the town electrician who can look at the lights. (GMP leased the lights to the town years ago, the lights only cost \$16-\$30/month to run during the usage season as per Pierre's discussion with Dayna at the town office). Replacement isn't necessary at this time, the WRC will not be asking for money for this at town meeting. (We do think it is a good idea to talk at the town meeting letting taxpayers know about the WRC, what we are doing and getting public input on new members and ideas). However, electrical infrastructure should be addressed as well as light positioning. Alycia will reach out to Kevin about the lights.
3. Estimate from Evan Theuer on stump removal and flattening the area in between the skatepark and tennis courts coming in at \$3,310. One full day and machine work. Alycia meeting with Chris Griffin tomorrow to get a second estimate on site work.
4. Pierre looked at bollards and counted around 100 that need replaced around the field. 17 more are damaged around the septic tank. 37 more are damaged around the solar panels. Lowell Landscape and Fence has been reached out to for an estimate for removal and replacement of the bad bollards. Pierre will be getting an estimate for just the bollards from RK Miles.
5. Backstop fencing removal needs an estimate, Pierre will ask Lowell for the cost. Alycia will ask Chris Griffin as well. Bob will consider if his machine has the capacity to pull up the fencing. It is 140 linear feet of fencing, 6' tall with a total of 16 posts.
6. As far as future projects, they are directly tied to the work of the Warren PTO. We have asked Shawn to help with trying to organize a meeting with them so that we can discuss these things. (Future basketball court, pump track, shade structure/outdoor classroom near basketball court). Would the PTO be willing to match a grant in order to build the basketball court?
7. 5 year plan:
 - Walking path around field, pump track, more parking, shade structure, basketball court, outdoor classroom, setting up systems for future endeavors and if the MRVRD would absorb the WRC at some point.
8. 2025 work to be done, tree work around SOS building, bollards, move blue shed to softball field area, stumping and placing port-o-let structure in its permanent spot.
