# **Building Design:**

Reviewed some plan changes related to mechanical and electrical equipment needs.

- Electrical room and water entrance/fire pump rooms identified and shown on plan
- Mechanical equipment space on mezzanine
- Storage extends slightly farther into the locker area.
- Exterior massing reviewed. Discussed covering person doors but decided to keep just the main entry with a roof over it. The main entry and roof are not visible from the approach driveway, however.

#### **MEP and Structural Design:**

-Pulled drawings up on screen to show progress for MEP and structural systems. Still some coordination and changes needed, but trying to capture cost items. WLA would like to abandon the geothermal concept as incentives are likely to go away and this building does not have a balanced winter/summer heat load, so geothermal efficiency will suffer over the long term. (post meeting note: MEP team has submitted loads and is awaiting GMP ability to serve letter.)

### Site Design:

- -Grading and utilities design in progress. Marked up version was reviewed identifying possible locations for heat pumps, transformer, generator, fuel station, and salt shed.
- VTRANS salt shed used as an example for sizing. Confirm this design is acceptable to the Town.
- -Discussed if it is ok to use fire pond as the water source for washing trucks. Cost wise, it would be best, but the recharge rate of the pond is unknown. Town to research if data exists. A storage tank recharged by well or grey water collection from roof would be the other options but would add to construction cost if needed.
